Carroll Community Festival

AGventure July 15-19

If you notice a bunch of kids in Canal Basin Park this week, it's the annual AGventure summer program sponsored by the Bloom Carroll FFA. New Sewer Line Project

The Village has received a grant and 0% loan to install a gravity line sewer to replace part of the old forced main line. In Phase I, 78 homes will be connected. Future phases will depend on funding. The project is expected to start sometime this fall. If you received a pink notice on your door about the public meeting held June 6 then your property is included in Phase I; if not, you will be in a future connection so you are unaffected at this time.

A gravity line is the best type of sewer system and will eliminate the black lid and tank in your yard and the Village's expenses in repairs, pump outs, and other maintenance costs. It will serve Carroll into the future. More info will be in the next newsletter after the bid opening.
